1) GICE:

The Placement Cell organized a placement drive by GICE (Goan Institute International Consociation of Education Pvt. Ltd.) on 27th January 2020 for the final year students of all streams. A total of 27 students (11 students from B.A, 11 from B.Com, 3 from B.B.A and 2 from M.Com) attended the drive. It began with a pre-placement talk, where the resource persons informed the students about the role, i.e. Skill Development Faculty Trainer. This was followed by 2 rounds – an interview round and a self-presentation round. A total of 23 students were selected.
