- Report in brief: The Health Centre of M.E.S. College of Arts and Commerce, Zuarinagar organized a Breast Cancer Screening Camp in collaboration with The Yuvraj Singh Foundation under the Swasth Mahila, Swasth Goa Project, "Youwecan". A technology, called IBE Device was used in the procedure of screening. A total of 35 female faculty and employees of M.E.S. College of Arts & Commerce, and M.E.S. Higher Secondary School participated in the Screening Camp. This project was funded by SBI Foundation, and Indian Institute of Finance and Banking, with capacity building support from the Directorate of Health Services, under the guidance of Govt. of Goa. The rationale of the screening camp was to train women on how to conduct self-breast examination and spread awareness on breast cancer. The screening camp was held at the Health Centre of M.E.S. College of Arts and Commerce, Zuarinagar on 2nd February 2022 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:45 p.m. Dr. Manasvi M. Kamat, Principal of M.E.S. College of Arts & Commerce, along with Ms. Maria Fatima D'Costa, the Chairperson of the Health Centre, and the committee members, Ms. Madhuri Marathe, Ms. Sandhya Ghogale and Ms. Mamta Kavlekar, thanked the team from Yuvraj Singh Foundation for their commitment and dedication towards a noble cause.
