

INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC)

The IQAC is a nodal agency that plays a central role in upgrading the competence and quality of each department in terms of teaching-learning process, resources, infra-structure, etc.

The objectives and functions of the IQAC:

- Sets the benchmark and parameters for ensuring quality in academic, administration and extension activities
- Acts as a think-tank to initiate plans and implement such activities and programmes contributing to the enhancement and sustenance of quality aimed at overall development of the institution
- Suggest, coordinate and monitor quality measures in the teaching-learning process
- Organising quality enhancement workshops/seminars/conferences for students, teaching and non-teaching staff
- Facilitate the integration of the various activities of the institution and institutionalise the best practices
- Obtaining and analyzing feedback from stakeholders
- Prescribing documentation formats for collection of data on quality parameters and function as a centralized centre of documentation of all activities, programmes conducted by the institution
- Preparation and submission of Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) to NAAC
