115 students from B.COM Semester IV, VI and M.Com. and Coopted members from B.COM Semester VI of MES College attended the programme.

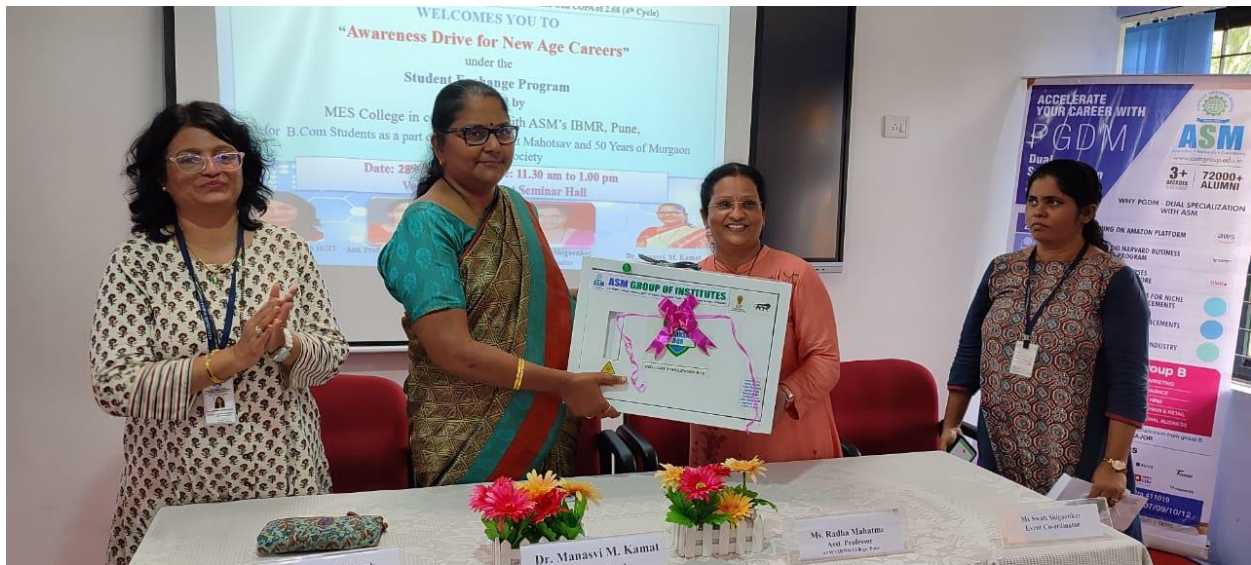
