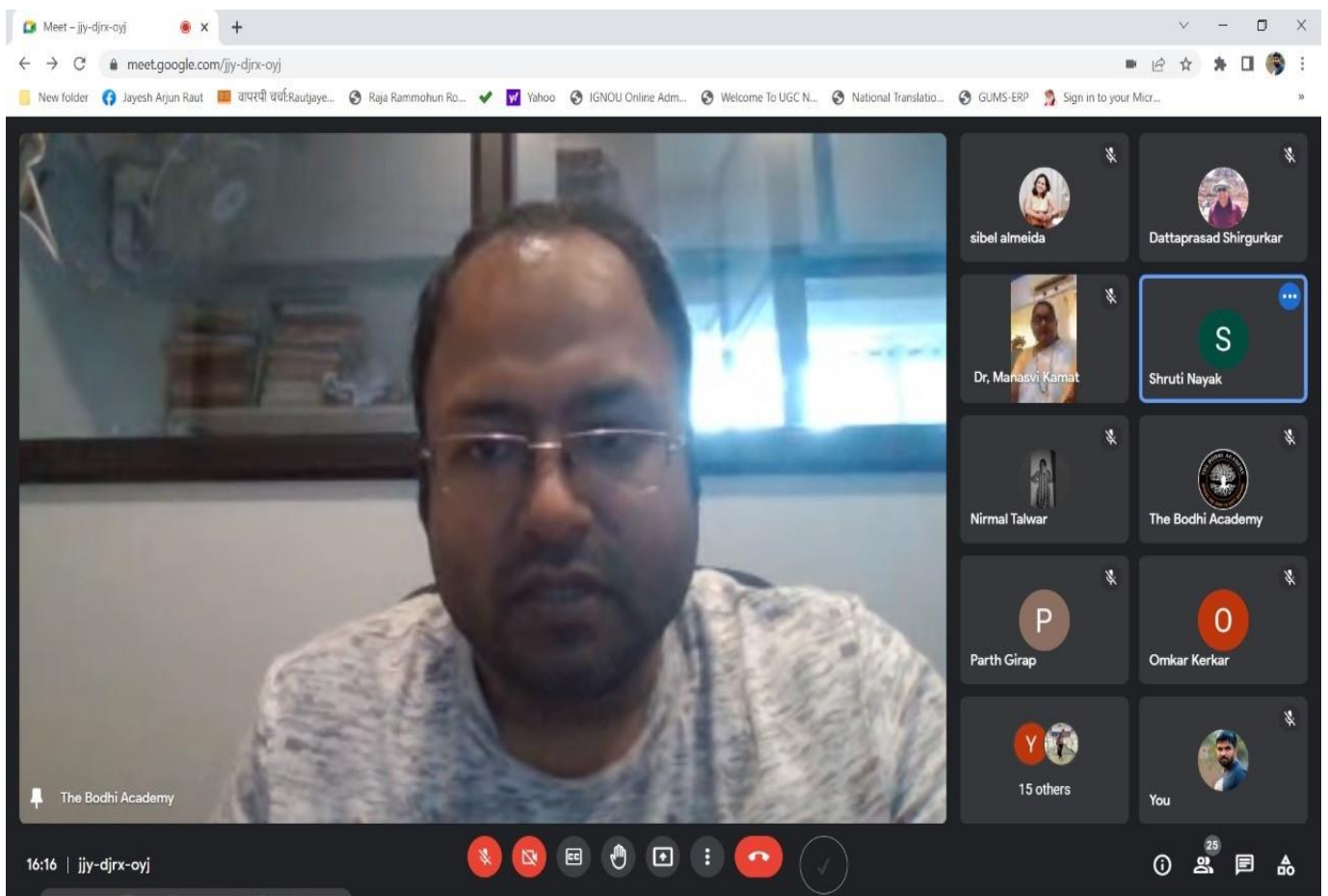
The Resource person for the webinar was Shri. Sushil Kumar Tripathi, Director, Bodhi Academy. Assistant Prof. Shri. Dattaprasad D. Shirgurkar introduced the resource person of the day. The webinar began by the resource person Shri. Sushil Kumar Tripathi stating that today the students have lot of openings for prospective career in government sector, corporate sector, in leading public sector banks and even in the UPSC (Union Public Service Commission) and SSC (State Service Commission) where they can make niche for themselves. The speaker threw light on the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) and stressed on the intricacies of it, such as the Qualifications, Number of Attempts, Reservations, Cut-off marks and the total number of services which comes under it. He also elaborately discussed on the Exam Cycle which takes an entire year to complete. He stated that the UPSC exam cannot be cracked by just being a bookworm. The last stage in the UPSC exam process is the personality test round, wherein the UPSC board would interview the candidate for assessing his/her personality and its suitability for a career in the services. This requires an all-round development of the individual apart from academic knowledge. He brought to the attention of the students that the IAS exam is not only challenging in terms of the length of its syllabus, but it is also daunting because of its highly

unpredictable nature. He also threw a light on the selection, salary offered, age limit, reservations, duration for preparation and exact time to start for preparation. The resource person also briefly touched upon the Goa Public Service Commission exams and updated them of the various topics and areas they should consider while preparing for these competitive exams.

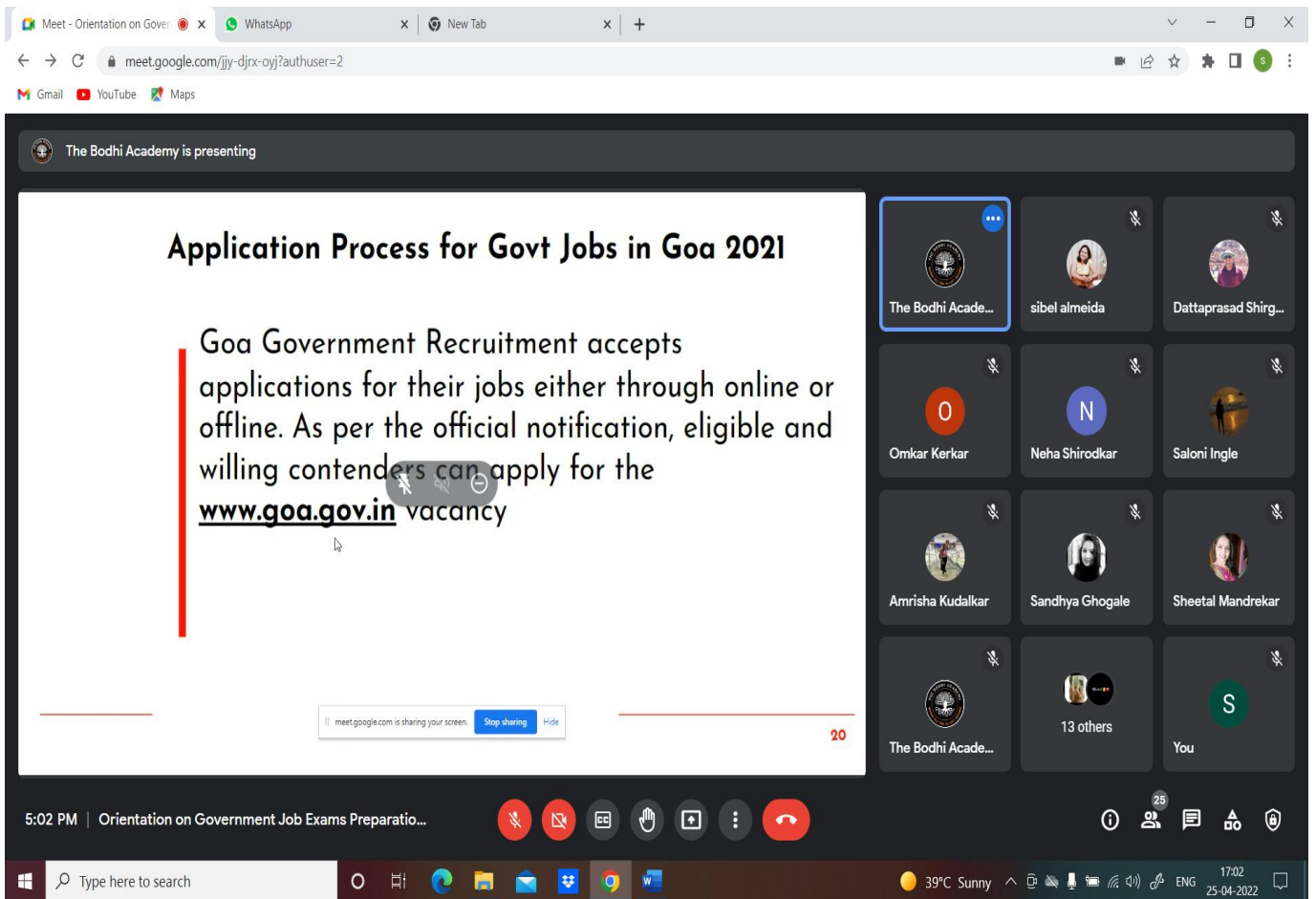

- **Remarks of the Coordinator:**

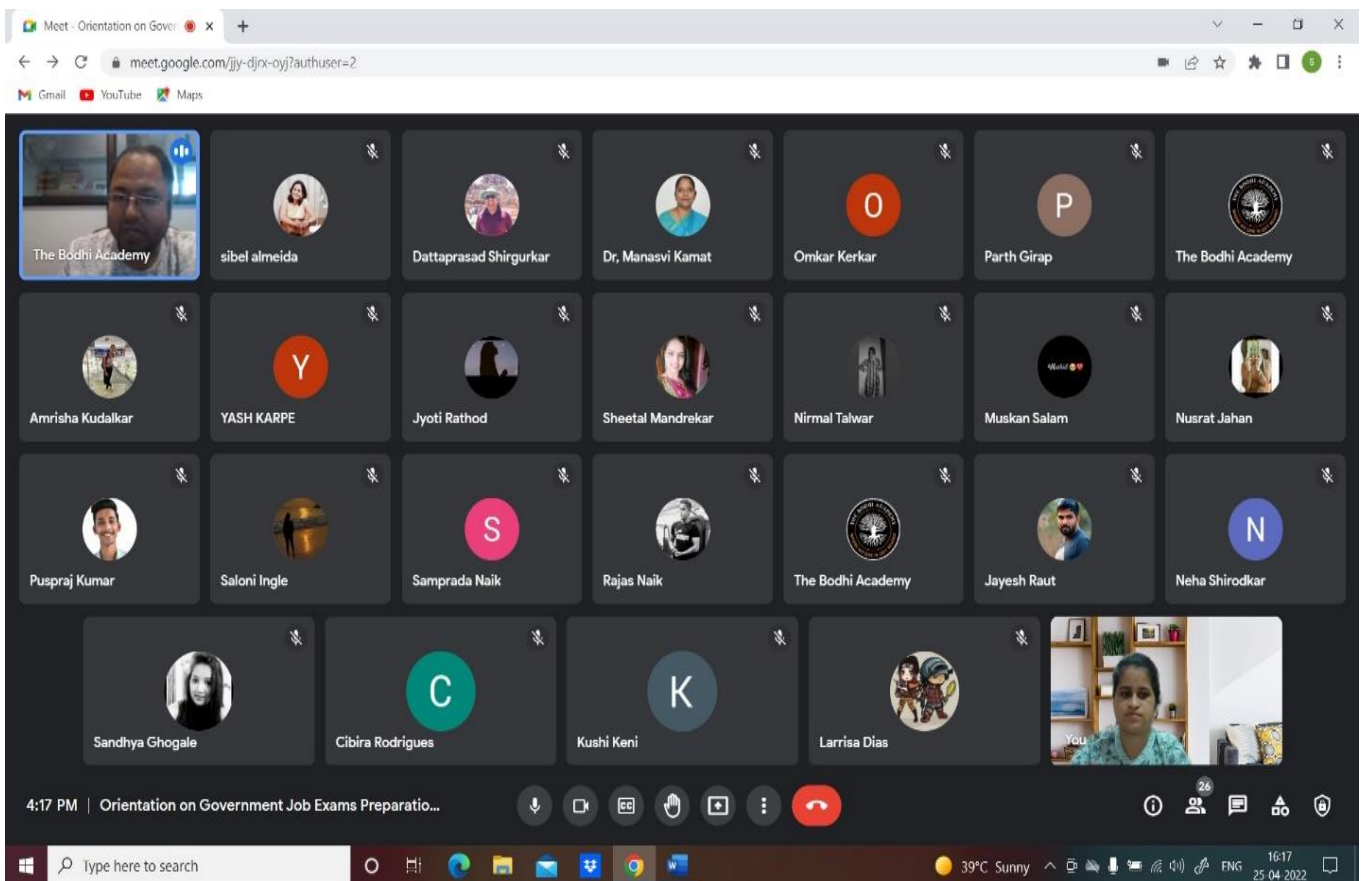
