1. Orientation to Third Year B.Com Students

- The students were informed about the SOPs to be followed by them while on the campus such as, wearing masks compulsorily, using sanitizers installed at college at various points, sitting on the same bench everyday while on campus, avoiding being together in a group, avoid shaking hands, hugging or any physical contact with others etc.

- The students were given a brief overview on the Commerce Association, the Commerce Fiesta 2021-22 and the various competitions to be held for TY B.com students.
- A brief discussion on Project lectures was also done to make students aware about the same.

2. Bridge Course

Department of Commerce organized a Six days Bridge Course for First Years B.Com students in Book-keeping and Accountancy. The objective of the course was to give background of Accountancy subject to the non-commerce students (Vocational and Science) who have taken admission for B.com semester I in our college.

The Bridge Course was conducted from 27th September, 2021 to 2nd October, 2021 between 1.00 pm and 2.00 pm through online mode. Twelve students from First Years B.Com had registered and attended the course. The Resource Persons were Ms. Thomasin D'Souza, Assistant Professor- Department of Commerce and Mr. Vasant Pednekar, Assistant Professor- Department of Commerce. Students had an active participation during the online sessions. The course was helpful to the students as seen from the feedback taken at the end of the course and gave clarity on basic terms/ concepts of Book-keeping and Accountancy. Considering COVID-19 Pandemic SOPs students were accommodated in the seminar hall and 3 classrooms where respective teacher in charge presented the ongoing session virtually in the respective classroom. Total 209 T.Y.B.Com students attended the orientation.



7. 4 Day Workshop on ‘SPSS’

A ‘4 Day Workshop on SPSS’ was organised by the Department of Commerce between 26th October 2021 and 29th October 2021 in M.S. Kamat Seminar Hall from 1.00 pm to 2.00 pm for the B.Com Semester V and M.Com Semester III students. The Resource person for the workshop was Mr. Suraj Prakash Tuyekar, Asst. Prof, P.G. Department of Commerce.

1st Day began with an inaugural function where welcome address and resource person was introduced by Dr. Champa R. Parab, Head, Department of Commerce. This was followed by a floral welcome where a potted flowering plant was presented to the Resource Person Mr. Suraj Tuyekar and ended with a vote of thanks given by event coordinator Asst. The topics covered include statistical concepts and its application, introduction to SPSS software. 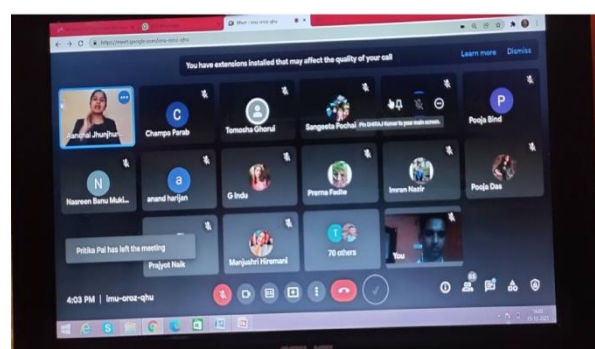


14. Webinar on “Career and Personal Development”
