training were provided on how to fill deposit pay in slip and withdrawal slip. Students performed a "Act" on the various scams and educated the participants through the act on "Never share bank details like ATM Pin, CVV code and Passwords" and the second Act showed the significance of saving money and government schemes available for the women, financial inclusion and so on so forth. The whole event for the benefit of participants was presented in Hindi and Kannada language and the programme ended at 1.30 pm.
