Report: As a part of 50 years of Golden Jubilee Celebration of M.E.S College of Arts and Commerce Zuarinagar Goa M.Com Department - M.Com Part II students organised an extension activity at **"Kiren Niketan Social Centre"** Birla Zuarinagar on the topic **"Financial Literacy**" which was conducted on 12th August 2022 from 9.30 am to 1.30 pm. The objective will be to financially educate and empower the women of the social centre.

The hands on training session on "Financial Literacy" was guided by the M.Com Programme Mentor Dr. Sancheliana Faria with Co-Cordinator Mr. Suraj P. Tuyekar, Mr. Pranit S. Naik and Ms Madhumeeta H. Dhar Assistant Professor in Commerce of M.E.S. College of Arts and Commerce Zuarinagar on 12th August 2022 between 9.30 am and 1.30 pm for 50 Women of Kiren Niketan Social Centre Birla Zuarinagar Goa.

The formal function began at 9.30 am with the introductory speech of M.Com Part II student Ms Haneen Khan and Ms. Lovely Parihar. of opening Account in Banks, Government Schemes, importance of education, Emergency funds, Fraud cases and Digital Banking like Google Pay through interactive power point presentations and skits .Hands on training were provided on how to fill deposit pay in slip and withdrawal slip. Students performed a "Act" on the various scams and educated the participants through the act on "Never share bank details like ATM Pin, CVV code and Passwords" and the second Act showed the significance of saving money and government schemes available for the women, financial inclusion and so on. The whole event for the benefit of participants was presented in Hindi and Kannada language and the programme ended at 1.30 pm.
