Report: The Post Graduate Department of Commerce organized an Orientation programme for the parents and students of M.Com Part I & Part II on 29th August 2022 in M.Com classroom. The objective of the programme was to orient newly admitted students of M.Com Part-I and also to provide details to the parents regarding the study tour organized for M.Com students in December, 2022. The programme was compered by Ms. Haneen Khan, a student of M.Com Part II.
