Objectives:

4. To contribute towards preserving the environment and taking effective steps in reduction of plastic pollution.

Strategies:

The strategies for ban on plastic in the institution are as follows:

- Conducting awareness campaigns by involving students, staff and stakeholders to reduce, reuse and recycle plastic.
- Create a task force to take up appropriate programmes to reduce use of plastic at the individual and community level.
- > Involvement of NSS & NCC units to keep the campus neat and clean.
- > Ban usage of plastics in canteens, college functions etc.
- > Prohibition of use of non-bio-degradable plastic items by staff and students.
- Keeping dustbins at strategic locations in the college to avoid littering the college campus.
- Training the students to make paper bags and distributing them in the neighbourhood as an alternative to plastic.
- > Provision of clean drinking water by installing water filters to curb the menace of plastic.
- > To establish and maintain tie ups with NGO's engaged in environmental issues.
