PERSPECTIVE PLAN

The perspective plan of the College Management is to provide access to higher education of global standards. When the college started in 1972, two undergraduate programmes, namely, B.A. and B.Com. were offered. To cater to the needs of the industry, the B.B. A and B.C.A. programmes were introduced in 2000 and 2001 respectively. Mormugao being a port town with a major port handling cargo exports and imports provides openings in this industry. To cater to the requirements of this industry, M.E.S. College introduced the bachelor's programme, namely, B.Com. in Shipping Management in 2009 under the 'Industry related Innovation Programme' of the UGC. The financial assistance from the UGC was for a period of five years, after which the programme migrated to B.B.A. Shipping and Logistics. It is being run as a self-financed programme.

The college has recently started the following need-based programmes:

Undergraduate Programmes:

1. B.B.A. Shipping and Logistics

Post- graduate Programmes:

1. M.Com.
2. M.A. English

Ph.D. Programmes:

1. Ph.D. Economics
2. Ph.D. Sociology

The Managing Committee plans to add Ph.D. Programmes in Commerce, Psychology and Konkani. The College has focused on enhancing the research capabilities by encouraging the teachers to acquire doctorates and to serve as research guides. At present fifteen teachers have Ph.D. degree, one teacher will soon be awarded his Ph.D. Degree and 13 teachers have registered for Ph.D. degree. The aim is to have all the full time teachers with Ph.D. degree at the earliest.

Environment sustainability is part of the strategic plan of the College. The College plans to engage in several Green Initiatives as it is the need of the hour to conserve and preserve our environment.



The College will be 50 years old in 2022. From then we shall prepare to acquire autonomy and by the time it steps into 75, it is to become a deemed University, focusing on providing state of the art facilities for exchange of knowledge and providing courses that meet the needs of industry and society. The proposed institute is to be named after Pandit Dharmanand Kosambi, a profound scholar of Pali, a world renowned authority on Buddhism and an ardent Gandhian. He hails from the neighbouring village of Sancoale. The time frame has been set to reach the level of autonomous college within ten years and the level of deemed university within fifteen years thereafter.
