- Report in brief:

The Career Guidance Cell of MES College in collaboration with YIN Gomantak, organized a session on “Career Opportunities in the 21st Century” for B.A/B.Com./B.C.A./B.B.A./B.B.A(Shipping and Logistics)/M.Com. students of MES College of Arts and Commerce, Zuarinagar-Goa. The session was held on Friday 9th September 2022 between 12:35 pm to 1:35 pm at M. S. Kamat Seminar hall of the MES College. The resource person for the session was Mr. Shekhar Bhat, CTO, Foxberry Technologies.

The Principal Dr. Manasvi Kamat welcomed the students and urged them to make use of such sessions to improve their knowledge and gain information for their own future.

In his session, the resource person Mr. Shekar Bhat highlighted on the fact that choosing a career path is each one's individual choice and one should consider the expectations of their career. This is based on a balance of materialistic and non-materialistic goals, for example, materialistic goals like financial wellbeing, fame, growth, recognition, while also considering the non-materialistic goals like contentment, happiness, fulfilment and social impact. Each person may decide to focus on a specific goal which is unique to him/her.

Mr. Bhat also enlightened the students on the keys to achieving their career goal, by being aware of who they truly are and their true potential, their destination, their definition of success, they should focus on what they can control, they should be committed, be coachable, set smart goals and should be able to manage uncertainty. He urged them to explore different options now during their graduation and acquire the skills necessary for their career choices. He explained

the areas of interest for students in the Humanities and Arts fields and said that nowadays there are a lot more options available for students to consider, so they should choose their career based on their interests and skills.

The session concluded with the Vote of Thanks proposed by Asst. Prof. Shruti Nayak, Chairperson of the Career Guidance Cell. Ms. Michelle D'Mello, The YIN Faculty Coordinator, was also present along with the committee members. The compere for the program was Ms. Muskaan Shaikh from B.A. semester III.
