• Reportin brief:

Department of Sociology, M.E.S. College of Arts and Commerce, introduced a Short-Term Certificate Course in "Digital Communication" for 30 hours duration during this academic year. The course was coordinated by Asst. Prof. Heena Shabali. The course began with an inaugural function held on 9rd January 2023 at 1:00 pm in the M.S Kamat Seminar Hall by lighting of the lamp. Dr. Manasvi M. Kamat Principal, Assistant Professor Jessy Coutinho, Asst Prof, Gulshan Mullah was present for the inaugural function along with all the participants. At the inaugural function, Asst. Prof. Heena Shabali the Course Coordinator, gave an overview of the course and importance of the course to the students. Dr. Manasvi M. Kamat, the Principal, presented her introductory remarks on the occasion and gave insights into the course outcomes.

Objective of the Certificate Course:

The session of the course started from 10thJanuary2023 in room no.17. The primary objective of this Certificate Course was to provide fundamental knowledge on the aspects of Digital Communication and toenhance their skills on the various forms of digital communication which is necessary in this technologically developing world. Total 15 sessionsof 2 hours from 1:00 pm to 3:00pm thereby completing 30 hours were held. Atotal of 28 students successfully completed the course. After completion of the course, students were evaluated based on a 50 marks exam, which was divided into two-part ,30 marks MCQ test and 20 marks Assignment. All 28 students qualified the exam and certificates were issued to the students.

Outcome of the Course: This course is very resourceful, beneficial and useful for the students as knowledge about means of digital communication is a must.
