• Report in brief:

The Career Guidance Cell of M.E.S College of Arts and Commerce, Zuarinagar – Goa organized a session on 'Career Prospects For Graduates In Government Sector' on 20th January 2023 in room no. 9 of M.E.S. College for the B.A/B.Com./B.C.A./B.B.A/B.B.A.(Shipping and Logistics) students of MES College. Shri. Dattaprasd D. Shirgurkar, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Political Science, M.E.S. College of Arts & Commerce, Zuarinagar, Goa was the resource person.

The session began with the welcome address by the Principal Dr. Manasvi M. Kamat. She stressed on the importance of career in Public sector and encouraged the students to take full benefits of the session by actively participating in the session.

The resource person explained the importance of career in Government sector. He explained why Government is an ideal employer, the benefits associated with career in government sector. The resource person explained the various categories of jobs available in the state government and semi government. He also explained the three different classes in government sector. The speaker spoke about Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) and explained qualifications, number of attempts, reservations, cut-off marks and the total number of services which comes under it. He also discussed in detail on the exam cycle. He explained the students on how to apply for the exam and made them aware of the various sources to refer for preparation. He explained in detail the syllabi and exam pattern for preliminary, mains and interview part of the examinations. He also spoke about the selection, salary offered, age limit, reservations, duration for preparation and exact time to start for preparation. The resource person also briefly explained about the Goa Public Service Commission exam and updated them of the various topics and areas they should consider while preparing for this competitive exam. The resource person stressed on the benefits of working in the public sector, such as the ability to make a positive impact on the society and the opportunity to work on important issues that affect the public. He also informed them about other benefits and perks of being a Gazetted Officer. The resource person also discussed about the career in banking sector and updated them of the various exams and syllabi they should consider while preparing for these exams. Further, he addressed the students as to how to prepare and study for such exams, what memory techniques to be used to remember the huge data, method of study, use of various websites which provide assistance for competitive exam aspirants.

He stressed on the need to read the various newspapers both national and local to keep themselves updated with the latest employment opportunities.

The session concluded with vote of thanks delivered by the Chairperson of the Career Guidance Cell Asst. Prof. Shruti B. Nayak. The session was compered by Asst. Prof. Priscilla David. All together 29 students attended the session which included 8 males and 21 females.
