
There should be opportunity for internship for students & more of implementing practical learning. Having enough teachers for all subjects that are in syllabus


More practicals should be conducted

The suggestion is that students should always thought the latest technological aspects which are upgrading in the market even though it is not included in the syllabus



Analysis of the feedback highlighted the following points.

- A total of 51 alumni responded to the feedback form. Majority of the alumni (66.7%) responded feeling proud to have been a student of MES College of Arts & Commerce.
- Many of the alumni (52.9%) agreed that college learning was useful in their career.
- Many (51%) others agreed that their education at MES was responsible for inculcating strong moral and ethical values in them.
- They (43.1%) admitted that key concepts were adequately addressed in each course/paper.
- Majority (51%) were of the opinion that adequate learning resources (e.g.books/journals,audio-visual materials, e-resources, etc.) were provided for program delivery and to actively engage students
- Many alumni (45.1%) acknowledged that the curriculum had immensely contributed to their knowledge, skills and overall personal development.
- Most of them (43.1%) informed that curriculum was designed to effectively meet the standards of 21<sup>st</sup> century job market.
- Some of the suggestions given by them include the following; including internship programs in the course content, introducing practical component, using videos specific to the topic covered in the syllabus, introducing skills based components to make them ready for employability, upgrading the syllabus to address current issues, should include case studies in major subjects to provide information about actual practical aspects of business and services sector like feeding bank statements in tally, writing vouchers in voucher book, analyzing balance sheets and profit and loss accounts of companies available online eg TCS, Reliance etc. to help in understanding business concepts like letter heads, drafting business related emails to clients and replying appropriately to clients on whatsapp.

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
