The workshop began with a welcome address by Principal Dr. Manasvi M. Kamat. She urged the participants to take maximum benefit of this workshop. Mrs. Sandiya Stefi Dourado, Event Coordinator, introduced the resource person, Dr. Mamta Kumari. Dr. Mamta Kumari delivered the keynote address. The DHE Observer, Ms. Anju Pai Bhale, College Librarian, Goa College of Music, Panaji, was also present for this workshop.

Dr. Mamta Kumari a renowned expert in LaTeX, captivated the audience with her engaging presentation, demystifying the seemingly complex syntax and showcasing the elegance and precision of LaTeX-generated documents. Attendees were then introduced to the fundamental building blocks of LaTeX, from basic commands to document structure. Through interactive exercises and live demonstrations, participants learned to create their first LaTeX documents, gaining practical experience in writing text, formatting paragraphs, and including mathematical equations.

The afternoon session delved deeper into the vast capabilities of LaTeX. Participants learned to enhance their documents with tables, figures, mastering techniques for referencing and styling. Advanced topics like creating custom commands and utilizing packages introduced students to the boundless possibilities of customization in LaTeX.

Throughout the workshop, the hands-on approach remained at the forefront. The resource person patiently addressed individual queries and facilitated peer-to-peer learning, fostering a collaborative and supportive atmosphere.

The workshop concluded with a valedictory session. Ms. Sindhuja Desai, Event Co-Coordinator proposed the vote of thanks. All together 58 participants attended the workshop which included 11 Males and 47 Females. Certificates of participation were awarded to the participants at the end of the workshop.


