Any suggestions for improvement:

Syllabus Relevance and Practical Knowledge

The current syllabus is generally good, but it could benefit from a stronger focus on practical knowledge and real-world applications. This would make the content more relevant to students' day-to-day lives.

Balance Between Functions and Exams

To avoid overburdening students, functions and exams should not overlap. Spacing them out would help students focus better on each.

Course Flexibility and Internships

There should be more flexibility in switching courses, along with clearer information about internship opportunities. Additionally, the psychology syllabus should prioritize practical and experiential learning over theoretical content.

Classroom Exercises and Personalized Attention

In-class problem-solving exercises, followed by similar homework, would enhance understanding. Teachers could invite different students to solve problems in class, providing personal attention and increasing engagement from all students.

Skill-Based Courses and Sports

Introducing skill-based courses like **Tally Prime** and offering more extracurricular activities, especially sports, would give students a more well-rounded education.

Critical Thinking and Political Culture

The syllabus should include elements that promote critical thinking and foster an understanding of political culture, preparing students for civic engagement.

Academic Guidance and Time Management

Teachers should guide students on how to improve their marks and provide notes well in advance of exams, preventing last-minute stress. Clear communication about the **New Education Policy (NEP)** is also necessary, as some students still struggle to understand it.

Foreign Language and Computer Skills

Adding courses in foreign languages and computer-related subjects would equip students with valuable skills for the future.

Interactive and Technological Learning

More interactive activities should be incorporated into the curriculum, and teachers should make better use of technology to enhance learning.



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
